- 2) Warranties on all riding sweepers including the ICC1, KM 100/100 R, KMR 1250, and KMR 1700 are 24 months parts/6 months labor OR 1000 hours of operation, whichever comes first. 
PAD INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION: Be sure power switch is turned off before performing any maintenance operations.

Pad installation procedure

1. Pull the machine back approximately 3' so that the rear casters pivot around to the reverse of their normal forward position.
2. Ensure that the foot pedal is UP instead of locked in the down position. The pad should be resting on the floor. Push firmly down on the handle to tip the unit back until it rests on both rear side "blocks". If the foot pedal is locked in the down position, the unit cannot stay tipped back.
3. Under the front pad shroud, locate the pad retainer plate. Grasp the pad holder to prevent turning, and twist the pad retainer counter-clock-wise to remove. Center the pad on the holder and press in place.
4. Replace pad retainer and hand tighten. - Do not over tighten.

CAUTION: Do not store unit tilted on its back. Charge in operating position only.
